

Membership and Member Services Of Men's Rights Fiji

In addition to membership services, we also recommend you sign up for.

For any human (men, women), who is over the age of 18 and shares the aims and objectives of the organization shall be eligible to become a member. Membership is subject to following rules and charter of the organization, and can be obtained upon the payment of an annual subscription fee which will be confirm later.

There shall be three types of members: individual members, organization members, group and commonwealth members will be entrusted with both strategic and day to day functioning of the organization in accordance with the rules and regulations.

Individual Members are authorized to have one vote in the Men's Rights Organization when the President called for General Meeting.

Organization Members are authorized to have two votes in the Men's Rights Organization when the President called for General Meeting.

Groups and Commonwealth Members have no votes in the Organization and they can give their suggestion to advocate Men's Rights Fiji.
